**May 2, 2022**

Cal Hastings called the meeting to order at 6:09 pm, stating that the meeting was properly noticed, and called the roll of those members attending:

The issue was raised of who should serve as Chairman as Cal indicated he wanted to stay Vice Chairman. Cal said he has been on the Board for 17-18 years and he is getting tired, and it is time for new blood and ideas.
