Paula congratulated the committee members on our achievement of conditional approval. This news has not been widely publicized and we will let other interested parties know.
- 3. Community Preservation Act Committee and Town Meeting updates. Each item of OSR as presented at Town Meeting was discussed, as well as the future role of the OSR committee. We are aware that the Lodge Park plan is moving along with the Ma Audubon consultant. Paula will followup with Town Administrator on progress of other projects, all of which were funded. Paula would like to see the OSR Committee be established in a town bylaw, and will also discuss this with Melissa Cryan of DCS.
