Project Description

Funding for this project will help rehabilitate the Gazebo at Bailey's Hill and make necessary repairs to ensure the gazebo maintains it's structure and beauty for years to come. The scope of this project aims to repair the roof, wood and cement railings, lattice and paint. The bushes and plantings around the gazebo will also be replaced as part of this project.

Contribution to the Preservation of Nahant's Unique Character

This project will help to preserve and enhance a historic Town structure. The Town has recently utilized funds from a previous CPC project to revitalize Baileys Hill and Fort Ruckman and we would like to continue renewing that area with the rehabilitation of the Gazebo. The Gazebo has long been used for the 40 Steps Dance Performance, Cultural Council Events and other Town gatherings. This important part of Town is very underutilized due to it's condition and we would like to continue traditional and future events.

· How will the proposed project contribute to the preservation of Nahant's unique character and enhance our quality of life?

The gazebo was built in the early 1900s and a restoration project was funded with CPA funds in FY06. It is a historic and unique feature of the open space and recreational area of Bailey's Hill Park. This project would help preserve the

structure for many years.

· Is the proposed project feasible?

Yes. The restoration efforts are simple and the Town has engaged in similar work in the past on this structure and others.

This project is not urgent however each year the gazebo continues to deteriorate. The roof leaks which leads to water damage of the structure below.

Yes, the estimated cost of the repairs have been vetted with the DPW Superintendent and the Building Inspector.
