Flash Road Recreation Master Plan

Project Description

This grant will fund technical assistance to develop a recreation master plan for Flash Road Park. The intended area extends from the Flash Road Playground to the Little League Majors Field behind the Johnson Elementary School. Annual Town Meeting in 2022 approved a CPA grant of \$11,000 to design an improvement of the Heritage Trail in this area of Town. If this grant is approved, the Town will utilize both grants, a total of \$31,000, for a combined effort. The Open Space and Recreation Committee and a recreational architectural firm would engage a public process to develop a master plan that will guide the Towns recreational investments in future years. The old Babe Ruth baseball field closest to the playground and basketball court has not been used as a baseball field in many years. The dugouts have been removed due to their deterioration and an infield no longer exists. The soccer field in this area abuts the Kelly Greens Golf Course and the Heritage Trail is hard to find. Additionally, the availability of parking is not sufficient, the Fire Lane to the Little League Majors Field is often blocked, and patrons often park, drive, or walk through an active DPW facility. The Town would like to gather public input on changes to this area that will improve the enjoyment of open space and promote safe recreation. The Town would like to explore 1.) Moving the soccer field away from the golf course and closer to the public restrooms by eliminating the old Babe Ruth baseball field fencing and seating, 2.) Adding a splash pad water feature playground next to the existing playground, 3.)

Installing a clearly marked Heritage Trail that could expand throughout the area, 4.) Improve the parking lot area to accommodate vehicles during high use of recreational facilities 5.) Improve the fire lane to the Little Leage baseball fields, 6.) Establish a boundary of the Public Works facility to avoid potential risks involving heavy machinery, and 7.) additional ideas/desires received through a public process. The adoption of Nahant's Open Space and Recreation Plan has provided the Town eligibility for state funded grant programs which could benefit the results of this study.

Contribution to the Preservation of Nahant's Unique Character

Flash Road Park is a centerpiece of Nahant's recreational opportunities. This area currently features a playground, a basketball court, two tennis courts, two pickleball courts, a soccer field, 3 baseball fields, a Heritage trail and general open space. This area is adjacent to the Kelly Greens Golf Course, the Community Garden, and the Johnson Elementary School which includes a forest playground, a half court basketball court, a playground, a gaga pit and more. A recreation master plan will help to improve the area by gathering public input and setting future capital improvements. Recent investments in recreational facilities around Town due to the funding of CPA grants has contributed to Nahant's unique character and developing a master plan for this area will continue such progress.

Annual Town Meeting in 2022 approved a CPA grant of \$11,000 to design an improvement of the Heritage Trail in this area of Town. If this grant is approved, the Town will utilize both grants, a total of \$31,000, for a combined effort. Should recreational facilities change, the Heritage Trail improvements should be designed in coordination with this effort. The Town would like to explore expanding the Heritage trail in this area to provide users multiple options and enhance their experience. Ideally, the future Heritage Trail in this area would connect all the recreational facilities instead of one single trail that traverses by the area.
