

ARTICLE 1: (Coast Guard Housing Demolition and Sale – Borrowing Authorization) To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds or borrow, a sum of money to pay all costs of preparation and disposition of the property on Castle Road and Goddard Drive (known as the Coast Guard Housing)(Assessors Map 12D-0-41 and being premises being described in a deed recorded in the Essex County Registry of Deeds in Book 24011, page 401), including the payment of costs related or incidental thereto, or take any other action relative thereto.

Motion 1: JULIE TARMY (Coast Guard Housing Demolition and Sale – Borrowing Authorization) *2/3rds vote*

I move that the sum of \$1,000,000 is hereby appropriated for the purpose of demolishing the houses, removing the in-ground oil storage tanks and levelling the land located on Castle Road and Goddard Drive, known as the Coast Guard Housing, and all costs related or incidental thereto, and, to meet this appropriation, the Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, is authorized to borrow said sum under and pursuant to G.L. c. 44, §§7, 8 or to any other enabling authority, and to issue bonds or notes of the Town therefor.
