**1. Request for Permit Extension, 50 Wharf Street (047-0566)**

MassAudubon

Request for a three-year extension to the ecological restoration Order of Conditions.

Much of the work approved under the permit is complete, however removal of invasive species is an ongoing process. MassAudubon requests an extension to continue their invasive species removal efforts.

Motion to issue a three-year extension made by Patek, seconded by Tibbits. Motion passed unanimously.

**2. Discussion regarding letter to MACC about East Point**

Patek requests that the Commission formally submit a letter to the Massachusetts Association of Conservation Commissions asking for their support in protecting East Point. East Point is an ecologically sensitive area and MACC's support is valuable in the legal effort to protect it.

Tibbits made a motion supporting the Commission's submission of a letter to MACC requesting their support in the legal effort to protect East Point. The motion was seconded by Famulari. The motion passed unanimously.
