Rules and Regulations

- (1) You must be a Nahant resident to apply for a permit and show proof of address.
- (2) Camp Fires are allow by permit on the following beaches; Short Beach, Tudor Beach, and Black Rock Beach, between **7:00PM and 10:00PM**. Permits **will not** be issued on the 4th of July or Labor Day. Limited to **7** Short Beach, **7** Tudor Beach, **5** Black Rock.
- (3) Campfires must be supervised (at ALL time) by the individual whom this permit is issued (signed below) who is at least 21 years of age, and a resident of Nahant. The applicant must be accessible by cell phone during the campfire. Applicant must provide proof of permit upon request of Police or Fire Department.
- (4) The size of the campfire shall not be more than 3' in circumference or height. Fires must be located far enough away from dune/beach grasses.
- (5) Burn only untreated, unpainted wood. Wood should not contain any nails or other hardware. Do not burn trash.
- (6) Do not use accelerants, such as lighter fluid, as they leave pollution and poison in the sand. Paper and kindling is preferred.
- (7) Do not put out fire with sand, let fire burn out or use water. Permit Holders are required to rake the fire area clean and remove all residue. All other Town rules, regulations and/or by-laws related to Town beaches shall remain in effect.
- (8) The Police and/or Fire Departments reserve the right to rescind the beach campfire permit at any time.
- (9) No Rain Dates – no refunds.
