

6. Ongoing Business

a. Vote to convert Colby Way into a One Way from Harris Street to Bass Point Road. Residents on this section of Colby Way will be allowed to enter the street from Bass Point Road.

Dan Skrip (Town Counsel): suggested a motion: "The Board of Selectmen will move to convert Colby Way, into a one way street, from Harris St., which is at the top of Colby Way, to Bass Point Rd, which is at the bottom of Colby Way, except for residents only privilege for the residents to enter Colby Way from Bass Point Road."

TA: We have spent some time on this, we had a meeting about it, a petition was submitted to the Town, we did a traffic count study, got feedback from residents in the area and are in support of the change. Spoke to the Chief of Police, Chief Antrim of Fire Dept. and DPW and they agree with the change.
