

TOWN OF NAHANT CURRENT PARKING POLICY

Residents must purchase a parking sticker to be able to park in the following beach lots: Lowlands/Short Beach, Town Wharf, Canoe Beach, and designated spots at Bailey's Hill, as well as for using the Town compost area. Individuals who own property and pay taxes in Nahant are eligible to purchase a parking sticker. Individuals who rent property in Nahant must provide proof of a rental agreement to receive a parking sticker. All outstanding bills with the Town of Nahant must be paid in full before a parking sticker is issued.

The Police Department will enforce all other parking in Town based on the street signage. For streets with signage that states "Resident Parking Only," the vehicle plate will be run to determine if the owner is a resident. For leased vehicles, residents must ensure that the registration reflects a Nahant address.

For guest parking, residents shall contact the Police Department with their request in advance. The Police Department will accommodate requests when feasible.

The Town has the right to implement a winter parking ban annually through a vote of the Select Board, which prohibits parking on the streets between midnight and 6am. A resident may apply for a winter parking waiver through the Police Department.
